Finalists will be selected and invited to present their work in person before the Judging Panel at the Student Paper Contest on the first day – 20 September 2011 of the Asia Pacific Oil & Gas Conference and Exhibition, Jakarta, Indonesia. Each finalist is limited to a presentation time of no more than 20 minutes. Total of submission was 13.

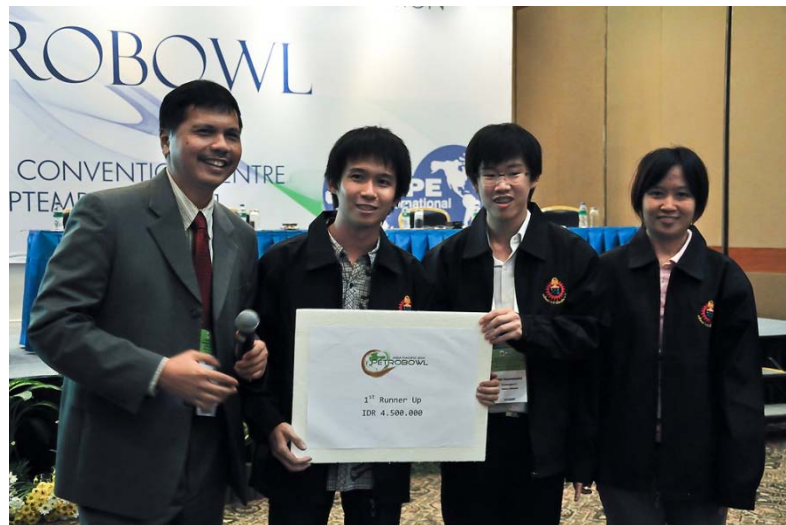
PetroBowl Competition 2011 will be established on 21 September in Jakarta, Trisakti University. It is a yearly competition matches three-person teams from participating universities under SPE Student Chapter against each other to answer questions ranging from the fundamentals of petroleum engineering to the history and current events of the oil and gas industry. All questions are to relate to the petroleum industry and petroleum engineering and also associate with basic knowledge in petroleum industry such as production, drilling, reservoir, operation practice, safety, and new E&P technology and innovation. They may consist of history, trivia, current events, technical questions, calculations and problem solving. There are totally 17 teams consists of 2 teams from Chulalongkorn University and 1 team from Suranaree University of Technology.

For student paper contest, Monthep Parimontonsakul, 4th year student in Petroleum Department, is the 2nd place winner in the student paper contest (undergraduate division).
